# Marie-Antoinette's estate



The reestablishment of the enclosure under Napoleon who took over the majority of the old layout (ramparts, portals, railings, and ha-has) means that today the Petit Trianon estate is still a unified area, private and preserved, centred on the palace in a wholly intimate setting.

This layout shows the refinement and eclecticism of Marie-Antoinette, emphasises her way of living and freedom of thought that was inspired by Enlightenment theories.

Within the framework of the project "Grand Versailles Numérique", the Château de Versailles offers the visitors of Marie-Antoinette's Estate a new tour guide that is free and available from the Petit Trianon reception.
